Cytisus Amber Elf

Characteristics:

Amber Elf is an outstanding compact variety of Cytisus, forming a neat dome-shaped plant with deep green foliage. The whole plant becomes completely covered with large amber-yellow flowers in early summer – a really striking display!

Cytisus Amber Elf is ideal for container gardening or for use in the border.

Hardiness: USDA zones 5 - 10

Bloom: large amber-yellow flowers in early summer.

Foliage: deep green. Retains juvenile foliage.

Habit: compact mounded habit. 50cm/20" high by 40cm/16" wide when mature.

Propagation: cuttings.
Note: a licence is required for propagation.

Culture: sunny position, well drained soil.

Additional information:

Cytisus Amber Elf has already been launched in the UK and has proven to be immensely popular.

It makes an excellent impulse plant in pots from 1 to 2 litres for sales in late spring and early summer.
