These popular varieties offer good branching habit, making for a dense plant packed with flowers. They have an exceptionally long flowering season, from late spring until autumn. Two colours are available with large flowers, soft pink (**Walberton's® Pink Fountain**) and white (**Walberton's® Snow Fountain**).

Hardiness: Hardy to USDA zone 5 (-25 Celsius)

Bloom: Large soft pink (Walberton's® Pink Fountain)
Large pure white (Walberton's® Snow Fountain)
Flowers from late spring until autumn.

Foliage: Mid green.

Habit: Dense compact mounded habit. 60cm tall when mature.

Propagation: Cuttings. Can be finished in 4-6 weeks from plugs (11cm pot).
Note: a licence is required for propagation.

Culture: Performs best in a sunny position in any good well-drained soil. Drought resistant.
