Geum Totally Tangerine

The breeder asserts ownership of all rights in this plant.

Characteristics:

A superb new variety of Geum that is totally sterile, thereby giving more flowers and an extended flower season. It produces at least five times the normal number of extra large warm tangerine-orange flowers, held on sturdy upright stems over attractive dark green leaves.

An excellent and easy-to-grow perennial with impact, for the herbaceous border.

Hardiness: Expected to be hardy to USDA zone 5 (-25 Celsius)

Bloom: Large warm orange flowers, paler golden orange towards the centre, in early summer, with repeat flowering later until late summer.

Foliage: Attractive rich green leaves.

Habit: Mounded foliage. Upright branching flower stems begin flowering at 45cm/18" and continue to 120cm/48"

Propagation: Cuttings, division or tissue culture
Note: a licence is required for propagation.

Culture: Performs best in a sunny position in any good well-drained soil that does not become very dry.

Additional information:

This is an excellent addition to the genus. It is best finished in a 1.5 or 2.0 litre container, or sold as a field-grown plant. A long season of flower will ensure a good shelf life in the garden centre.
