Characteristics:

Strawberries and Cream is an excellent new Hebe hybrid from a controlled breeding programme at one of Europe's leading Hebe specialists. It has narrow, spear-shaped leaves with dark pink young shoots and a neat mound-shaped habit. Dense heads of strawberry and cream flowers in summer – an exceptionally showy plant.

Strawberries and Cream will be popular as an impulse plant for sale both as a foliage specimen or when in flower.

Hardiness: has survived frost to -4 Celsius in trials. Drought resistant.
Bloom: dense heads of strawberry and cream flowers in summer.
Foliage: narrow, spear-shaped leaves, with dark pink young shoots.
Habit: dome-shaped habit. 50cm high when mature.
Propagation: cuttings. **Note: a licence is required for propagation.**
Culture: full sun or light shade, any good well-drained soil.
