Heliopsis helianthoides Tuscan Sun

Breeder: Bred at University of Minnesota by Dr. David Zlesak, with collaboration of Brent Hanson, Rhineland Nursery, Wisconsin

Protection status: US Plant Patent #PP18,763.
EU PVR applied for (CPVO file number 20082967)

Characteristics:

Tuscan Sun is the shortest variety of Heliopsis available growing to a compact 45cm – a fraction of the height of conventional varieties. This extremely well-branched dwarf plant is a natural fit in modern gardens. Its size makes it perfect for container gardening and smaller gardens. Tuscan Sun is free flowering and has strong green foliage.

Tuscan Sun is ideal for containers, front of the border and is ideal where space is limited. It could potentially be sold alongside annuals or perennials.

Hardiness: USDA zone 3 (minimum temperature -35 Celsius). Also tolerant of high summer temperatures.

Bloom: yellow flowers with golden centres, 6cm in diameter

Foliage: dark green leaves similar to other Heliopsis (although smaller)

Habit: compact, well branched, bushy. 45cm/18"

Propagation: soft cuttings. **Note: a licence is required for propagation.**

Culture: sun, any good soil.

Additional information:

Heliopsis Tuscan Sun is very fast to finish – plants in 10cm pots can be produced in just 4 weeks from plugs, while plants in 2 litre pots can be produced in just 8 weeks (although this depends on growing conditions).

This plant has already been successfully launched in the US and in the UK.
