Characteristics:

Confetti Frosted Pink is an excellent and stable new variegated form of Nemesia Bright Pink Confetti. The foliage has bright, distinctive and stable variegation which combines well with the familiar bright pink scented flowers. In addition, the foliage does not burn when planted in hot sunny positions.

Nemesias are excellent plants for bedding and container gardening, or for use in hanging baskets. In milder areas, they can also be used in the perennial border. This variety is being sold in the EU and US as Nemesia Jubilee.

Hardiness: treat as annual bedding in colder climates.

Bloom: bright pink, lightly scented.

Foliage: bright cream margins.

Habit: neat and bushy with a compact mounded form.
30cm high when mature.

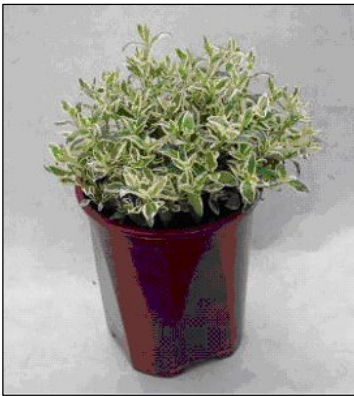
Propagation: cuttings. **Note: a licence is required for propagation.**

Culture: full sun or part shade, any good soil.

Additional information:

Nemesias make excellent plants for impulse sales in container sizes ranging from 9cm to 1.5 litre, or in finished tubs and hanging baskets.
