### Prunella Summer Daze

#### Characteristics:

Prunella Summer Daze represents an amazing step forward in the development of this neglected genus. This new hybrid variety makes a compact semi-evergreen plant with masses of showy heads of large flowers in vibrant rich pink. The oak-leaved foliage is also attractive.

Prunellas are excellent plants for the border or for use in tubs and containers for summer colour, flowering from June to September. They are happy in most soils.

Hardiness: USDA zones 4 or 5 to 8 (minimum temperature -30 Celsius) – to be confirmed by trials.

Bloom: vibrant pink hooded flowers in tight heads. June to September.

Foliage: attractive oak-leaved mid green semi-evergreen foliage.

Habit: compact perennial growing to 25cm high when in flower.

Propagation: cuttings. **Note: a licence is required for propagation.**

Culture: sun or light shade, any good soil.

#### Additional information:

Prunella Summer Daze makes outstanding impulse plants for summer sales, finished in 1 litre or larger containers.

This plant is from an on-going breeding programme. Successful licensees for Summer Daze will be given first-refusal on future varieties from this programme.
