



Ranunculus Rococo series

FOR GARDEN OR CUT FLOWERS

Origin: bred in England

Protection status: breeder's rights asserted

Variety names: not yet named

Benefits of these varieties:

- Hybrids between *Ranunculus asiaticus* and a hardy species.
- Long strong branching stems.
- Hardy to at least -12°C in trials.
- Great for garden or for use as a cut flower.
- Vase life around 10—14 days.
- May be transported and sold as dry tubers.
- Huge range of colours in development.

Characteristics:

- Height: 65cm—75cm
- Flower diameter: 6-7cm
- Flowering time: April-June (natural season, but may be forced)
- Foliage: similar to *R. asiaticus*
- Habit: upright
